## **Process Paper**

Our topic was about the Iranian Hostage Crisis which we thought was an important topic to cover. The title of our project is Diplomacy of The Iranian Hostage Crisis: Success, Failure and Consequences. Our inspiration for our 2022 National History Day project first came to us when we found out one of the citizens of our town was a former hostage. We were also very interested in our topic because we knew it had impacted America's relationship with Iran till this day. We enjoyed creating a website based on this topic because we learned as much as we could so we could inform others about the significance of this historical event.

We conducted our research by using websites, our local library and an interview with a former hostage. The websites we found to be the most informative to the research of our project were the Jimmy Carter Library, National Archives and Youtube videos.
